PRIMA is a partnership focused on the Mediterranean, uniting 20 **Participating States** (**PS**) from both the Northern and Southern shores and the European Union.

The partnership includes:

12 EU and 3 H2020 associated countries and 5 third countries signing an international agreement for Science and Technology with the European Commission.

PRIMA offers a unique platform for strengthening cooperation between EU Member States and third countries, fostering joint projects to address common challenges in the region and beyond.

EU PS and non-EU PS work together on an equal basis, sharing decisions, funding, and management responsibilities.



PRIMA's vision is to foster joint research and innovation (R&I) approaches among Mediterranean countries to improve water availability, sustainable agriculture and food production in a region heavily distressed by climate change.



With a budget of EUR 700 million, PRIMA implements the Programme mainly through calls for proposals.



PRIMA: a pioneer for the **WEFE Nexus**

PRIMA's integration of the WEFE Nexus theme since 2019 is crucial for achieving its objectives.

The 1st round of PRIMA Calls is launched, focusing on three key themes: Water management, Agro-Food, and Farming Systems.



The WEFE Nexus is introduced as a 4th thematic area, with 3 projects funded under this new thematic.

SCIENCE DIPLOMACY

PRIMA has proven to be an instrument facilitating cooperation between teams from North/South and South/South countries.

ALIGNING NATIONAL REGULATIONS

Aligning national regulations and administrative procedures: PRIMA effectively fostered collaboration among countries that had not previously worked together.













PRIMA'S NEW HORIZON: FUTURE4PRIMA

The recently granted CSA FUTURE4PRIMA project (Horizon Europe), led by PRIMA Program, (starting in January 2024 with 21 partners).

Objectives: prepare for a possible extension of PRIMA from 2028, potentially broadening the thematic focus, extending the partnership to other potential candidates, to prepare for a possible EC impact assessment, foster policy adoption and accelerate the adoption of innovations by the market with a pilot proof of concept.
